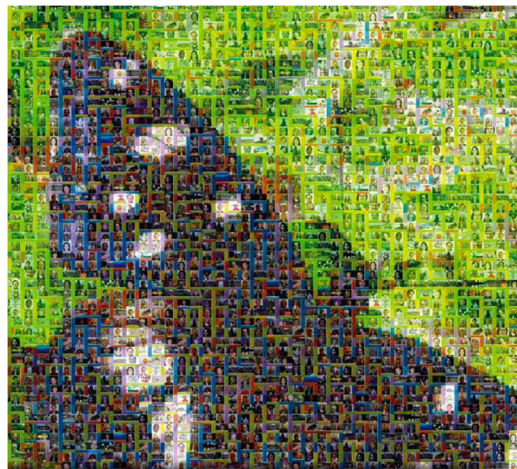

'Greening' the Humanities: Opening New Horizons for Research through the Prism of Biodiversity

In a context of global environmental crisis, this workshop will focus on **biodiversity** as a multifaceted concept that can be explored in two directions by scholars in the humanities:

- to address the issue of biodiversity loss from a new perspective and contribute in their own ways to the ecological transition
- to take a leaf from the book of biodiversity studies in terms of theories and methods in order to open new horizons for research in the humanities.

A transdisciplinary and transcultural perspective will be chosen to assess the heuristic value of biodiversity as a means of **'greening'** the humanities in innovative ways.

Six sessions of close reading and discussion (= 10 hrs) by Marie-Lise Paoli and international guest speakers from the UK, Romania, Canada and Iran are scheduled as follows:
